At Monday's Industrial Development Authority meeting he accused The Recorder of using "trick photography" in its picture of a Tucker County wind turbine. Smith, and others, may believe The Recorder has not presented all the pertinent facts on wind energy, but we stand by the scope and fairness of our reporting. And our research leads us to the same conclusions we've maintained for more than a year: This kind of development is not right for Highland.
